The Centre for Human Rights is publishing the present booklet within the programme of activities carried out in commemorations of the fortieth anniversary of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights... In resolution 42/131 December 1987, the Assembly reiterated this request pursuant to which this fifth edition of the Compilation, which includes instruments adopted up to 31 December 1987, is issued. The date of entry into force is given for all international conventions. A list of the instruments arranged by chronological order of adoption appears at the end of the volume. On the occasion of the International Year for Human Rights and the International Conference of Human Rights en 1968 the then Division of Human Rights of the United Nations Secretariat prepared the first compilation of international instruments relating to human rights, which consisted of the texts of conventions, declarations and certain recommendations adopted by the United Nations up to 31 December 1966... It is hoped that this compilations will contribute to a wider knowledge and an increased awareness of international human rights standards and will prove to be of value to all those interested in the promotion and protection of human rights and fundamental freedoms" ("Introduction" de esta obra).
